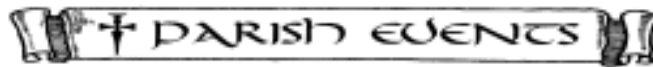

BONE MARROW DRIVE! On Saturday, May 17, from 10 AM - 4 PM OLR is hosting a city-wide bone marrow registry drive in honor of our 10 month-old parishioner Katie Belle Cooley, daughter of parishioners Stacey & Karen Cooley and granddaughter of parishioners Nick & Marie White, who has been diagnosed with infant leukemia. Katie-Belle and thousands of others may need a bone marrow transplant. The registry has about 6,000 inquiries a day for bone marrow. To register, a mouth swab is required for initial matching tests. You could be a match and help save a life by donating bone marrow. During the month of May, the costs of the tests are covered. Plan to come and register May 17th and stay for Mass celebrated by Bishop Luong and the dinner to follow!
