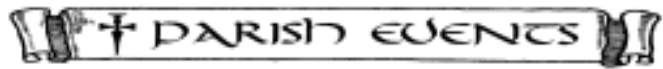

WORD OF LIFE: "In February 2005, Sara Scantlin of Kansas awoke from the 'persistent vegetative state' she had been in since a drunk driver hit her in 1984 when she was 18... 'Since 22 September 1984, Sara Scantlin had never uttered a word, her brain so badly damaged...that experts said she would spend the rest of her life in her own silent world...[Since she awoke, her parents] have listened in astonishment as she reels off the names of relatives, former pets, friends from school and dates...Her doctor, Bradley Scheel, says critical pathways in Sarah's brain...have regenerated and kicked back into life...A very important part of this case is the fact that throughout her 20-year coma, Sarah could, see, hear and understand what was going on around her."
